### 1.12: MetaMask and Ledger Nano

#### INTRODUCTION

Module 1.11 described in detail how to set up MetaMask for use as an online web wallet.

All web wallets suffer from a significant risk of being hacked by malicious actors often using a form of phishing scam.

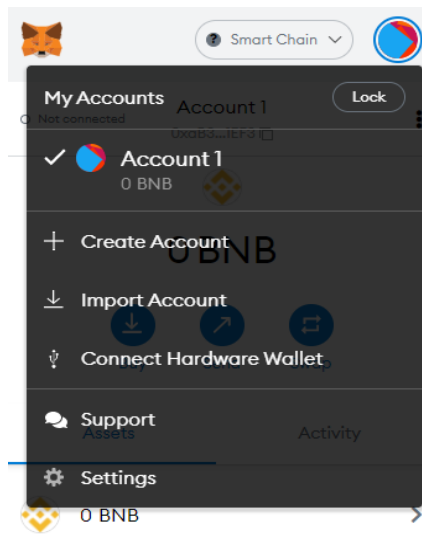
But there is a simple solution to hand. It is possible to combine the security of Ledger Nano with the utility and ease of use of MetaMask. This module tells you how.

#### METAMASK INSTALLATION

#### CONNECTING LEDGER NANO

Once MetaMask has been set up, type in your password, and click on the icon top right corner. A drop-down menu includes the option to “Connect Hardware Wallet”.

On the next screen click “Ledger” and you will be invited to plug in your Ledger Nano and open the Ethereum app. Click continue and connect.

You will then be prompted to open Ledger Live, the desktop application that is used to manage the firmware and apps for Ledger Nano. The next step is to approve the bridging process – again a simple click – select the appropriate account and you are in!

All transactions using MetaMask now need to be approved first on your Ledger Nano – nothing can happen without your express permission.
